



Regulation Wallball Court Dimensions



This is a regulation sized wallball court. It's quite big! We know that many venues won't be able to accommodate this – at least not in the first instance. The beauty of Wallball is that you can adapt the court size to the space you *do* have.

Having a regulation court opens up options for hosting events, such as International Opens, etc. but if you just want to get going then remember our motto:

ANY WALL, ANY BALL, ANY TIME

DIY Court

Cost: ~£0

Get going right away with a DIY Court. All you need is a wall and you're good to go. Get some chalk, paint or, like in this photo, masking tape.

Here we've marked a court on the wall and the floor with tape. We used this court for the UK Nationals Beginners' Grade. We've used similar courts in dozens of schools.

You'll get the odd uneven bounce but that doesn't matter. Adapt it to the space you've got and perhaps use pipes/existing cracks in the walls as boundaries as well.

Main Features:

Essentially free

Adapt the size to the space you've got available

What you need: tape/chalk/paint

Great for the playground

Great for a temporary court

Existing smooth wall?



Marked Court

Cost: ~£20

If you have an existing smooth wall, either outdoors or indoors, you can mark the court up with line marking tape or paint.

The closer the court gets to a regulation size, the more options are opened up in terms of hosting competitions and clubs, etc.

Skirting board may be an issue. To start with you can play over it, but later ideally you'll want to remove the skirting board and create a crisp angle between the wall and the floor.

Main Features:

Very cheap

High quality court – either indoors or outdoors

What you need: paint or heavy duty tape

Great for schools and clubs

Just lines = non-obstructive when not in use.

Great for all levels of the game through to top competition

Indoor Panel Court

Cost: ~£500 per court + labour

If you want to build a top quality court on a slightly uneven breeze-block or brick wall, then you can simply screw panels into the wall.

At the venue on the left we built four regulation courts. This venue has hosted the UK Open 6 times.

If an individual panel get damaged it can easily be replaced. They can also be decorated easily.

You may have to build out a small scaffold if there is piping, etc. on the wall. Cost will increase slightly.

11 x panels of standard plywood or MDF will size a regulation court.

Main Features:

Low cost

High quality

What you need: plywood/MDF, paint, line marking tape

Great for sports halls and community centres

Safe and non-obstructive

Easily repaired and decorated

MUGA/Outdoor Area



Outdoor Court

Cost: ~£1500 per court + labour

MUGAs and are great areas for Wallball and simply add another safe activity to the area without causing obstruction.

Walls are extremely versatile. When not being used for Wallball they can used as a tennis practice wall, target-practice football goal, billboard, etc.

We used to use marine-ply but now recommend a slightly more expensive material called Eco-Sheet. This panel is 100% recycled, easy to paint, easy to cut and is completely weather-proof.

Main Features:

Relatively low cost

Adds another activity to an outdoor area

What you need: panels, scaffold, paint

Great for the communities and schools

Perfect for community engagement

Damaged panels easily re-painted or replaced

On the move or doing a demo?



Portable Court

Cost: ~£1000-5000 (size dependent)

Portable courts are great for running demos, adding a temporary court to a venue/competition or permanent court that gets stored away after use.

The picture on the left is a full size court, but portable courts can be much smaller, especially if being used for demos.

They are very cost-effective and excellent for demonstrating the sport to a multitude of people. The panels can be branded easily.

Main Features:

Very versatile

Great for demonstrating the sport in a variety of spaces

Requires storage & construction each time

Excellent high-impact branding

Highly cost-effective

Useful for adding additional courts to an event as well

Standalone outdoor court – option 1



Breeze block & plaster

Cost: ~£8000 per court

Breeze block walls with a strong foundation and a plaster finish to smooth the surface has been a popular choice for walls in Europe.

Walls are solid and make a statement. They are fantastic for playing on and can also be used for high-impact branding space.

They are easily decorated and great for competition. Strong plaster may need repairing over time (years).

As always, walls can be used for other activities.

Simple, bold and effective

Standalone outdoor court – option 2



Concrete Court

Cost: ~£15,000 for 2 courts

Wallball has its root in New York City street-culture. New York has over 2,500 courts across the city, free to use all day long by anyone.

The courts are part of the culture now and provide free activity and exercise for anyone, regardless of background.

The courts are weatherproof concrete slabs with strong foundations underground. Again the courts are versatile and can be used for other activities. They can also be decorated.

Main Features:

Tried and tested over 2,500 times

Permanent

1 court = actually 2 courts. Front and back



Shipping Container Court

Cost: ~£7000 for 2 courts

We think this could be the future. 2 x 20ft shipping containers stacked on top of each other = a full size regulation Wallball court. Actually it's two Wallball courts as you can use the front and the back.

The containers will require the sides to be panelled to make the walls smooth.

You'll also have loads of indoor space within the containers for storage, an office or even a pop-up cocktail bar!

Trailblazing outdoor court, recycled and inspiring

Relatively low cost. 2 courts for the price of 1

Semi-permanent as they can be moved and transported

Great for parks and outdoor spaces

Indoor secure area for a variety of uses


